

How-to Connect a Brailiant to a Laptop

Confirm JAWS is installed



Install Brailiant BI Drivers: [Brailiant Drivers](#)

- Run Installer Wizard, Select "Install Drivers for JAWS 10 or Later"
- Can leave all devices selected
- For Default Braille Display selection in Wizard, choose "Brailiant B and BI"
- Finish Setup, choosing USB

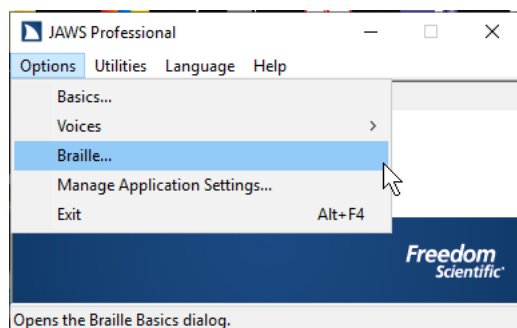
Turn on Brailiant BI (via Power button on right side), and plug into Laptop's USB port



Open JAWS

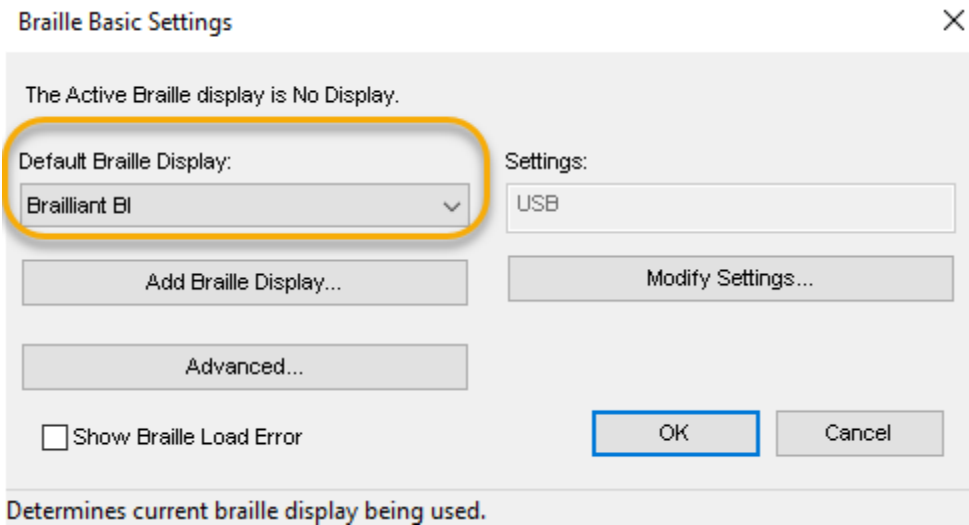


Click Options → Braille (Alt O,L)



Check if Default Braille Display says: Brailiant BI

- If it says Yes, click Ok
- If not default, Click Add Braille Display, scroll through the list, and check Brailiant BI. Click OK.
Choose USB for the port.
