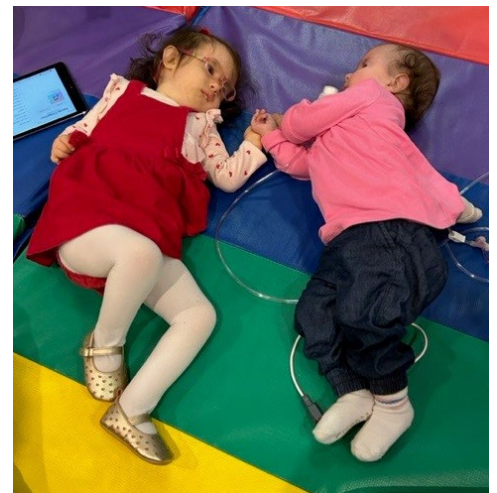
## Foundation for Blind Children hosts Tucson “Play Date” for Families with Visually Impaired Children
